



Thanksgiving Safety

Tips:

Thanksgiving Day has more than double the number of home cooking fires. To help prevent fires this holiday the Red Cross suggests the following tips:

- Keep potholders and food wrappers at least 3 feet away from heat sources.
- Wear tighter fitting clothing with shorter sleeves when cooking,
- Make sure all stoves, ovens and ranges have been turned off when you leave the kitchen.
- Set timers to keep track of turkeys and other food items.
- Turn handles of pots and pans on the stove inward to avoid accidents.
- After guests leave, designate a responsible adult to walk around the home making sure that all the candles and smoking materials are extinguished.

Driving In Foul Weather:

In stormy conditions, it is more difficult to see other vehicles, road signs and the road itself. It is critical to be more alert when driving in slippery conditions and to make sure you can see and be seen. Here are several important suggestions for driving in foul weather:

- First and foremost: slow down! It takes you longer to stop or adjust in wet weather.
- Stay towards the middle lanes! Water tend to pool in the outside lanes.
- Maintain proper following distance (4 second rule).
- Drive in the tracks of a car ahead of you.
- Don't follow cars or large trucks or buses too closely.
- Brake earlier and with less force than you would normally.
- If you must pass, do so quickly and safely.
- Don't use cruise control.
- Watch out for brake lights in front of you.
- Turn your headlights on even in light rain, or in gloomy, foggy or overcast conditions.
- Avoid using your brakes; if possible, take your foot off the accelerator to slow down.
- Avoid off-road driving: It's too hard to judge the actual depth of puddles and you can easily become stuck.
- Never drive beyond the limits of visibility.
- When driving through a puddle of certain depth, go slow.
- Allow for more travel time and if its raining so hard that you cant see the road or car in front of you- pull over and wait it out!
