More than 700,000 work-related eye injuries occur each year and 90 percent of all these eye injuries can be prevented with the appropriate protective eyewear. All it takes is a tiny sliver of metal, particle of dust, or splash of chemical to cause significant or permanent eye damage. Flying objects are the leading cause of eye injuries in the workplace; and a significant number of those objects are smaller than a pinhead. If you are working outside you are at a greater risk of injury and should always wear some type of eye protection. If you are looking at the computer screen all day it is suggested that you take frequent breaks, the screen will not damage your vision but it can contribute to eye strain. Here are a few tips that could help:

1. While playing any sport that involves a ball or other object that could strike your eye, make sure that you are wearing protective gear like a helmet or glasses.
2. Harsh light should be avoided. Wear sunglasses when you are out in the sun, proper glasses will keep your eyes well protected from intense light.
3. Goggles or safety glasses can protect your eyes from dust or flying debris.
